My name is Carley and I am the Shelter Supervisor at Sheepfold. Part of my role includes leading trainings for our House Manager staff. Recently, I felt the Lord impress upon me hours before our scheduled training to change my agenda and instead lead our staff through suicide prevention training.

To my surprise our newest House Manager had to utilize the training just a few short weeks later. Our House Manager was able to walk alongside one of our residents who was struggling through some of the darkest days of her life. We were able to be a safe place where she could confess her intentions of self-harm. We were able to transport her child to someone safe, and take her to the hospital.

Sometimes being a House Manager means sitting in a cold sterile hospital room late into the night offering support and prayer for someone who feels completely hopeless, abandoned and lost.
